


Did You Know That...

- Arthritis is the leading cause of disability in Pennsylvania and affects over 3 million adults¹ - more than combined totals of Cancer, Diabetes, and Heart Disease.
- In Pennsylvania, Arthritis costs an estimated **\$5.57 Billion** in medical expenses each year and an additional **\$684 Million** due to absenteeism and lost productivity.²
- There are over 100 diagnosable types of arthritis which include Osteoarthritis, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Gout, and Lupus. There are also temporary types of arthritis that can be brought on by infections like influenza.³

Who Has Arthritis?¹



- Although it is considered to be an age-related condition, Arthritis can impact anyone regardless of age.
- In Pennsylvania, women have a higher frequency of arthritis (34%) compared to men (25%).
- 41% of Pennsylvania Veterans are diagnosed with arthritis - 11% higher than the state average.

Arthritis & Other Conditions¹



- 43% of Pennsylvanians with asthma have diagnosed arthritis.
- 63% of Pennsylvanians with heart disease have diagnosed arthritis.
- 56% of Pennsylvanians with diabetes have diagnosed arthritis.
- 42% of Pennsylvanians who are obese have diagnosed arthritis.
- 100% of Pennsylvanians diagnosed with arthritis have a chronic disease that has no cure.

Arthritis Tips

- For every 1 pound of weight lost, 4 pounds of pressure is removed from the knees. By losing only 10 pounds you can relieve 40 pounds of pressure on your knees!³
- Consult your rheumatologist to see if arthritis self-management classes might help manage your arthritis-related pain. Ask your doctor for a referral to a course near you or contact the Pennsylvania Department of Health.
