### **George P. Hartwick, III, County Commissioner, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania**

George P. Hartwick, III, is in his fourth term as commissioner on the Dauphin County Board of Commissioners. Hartwick has primary oversight of the County's Human Services Department, Tax Assessment Office, Veterans Affairs, Children and Youth, Juvenile Probation, Area Agency on Aging and other initiatives. He was nominated to serve as the Chair of the Human Services Committee for CCAP (County Commissioners Association of PA) and he was elected as Pennsylvania's representative to participate in the NACo County Leadership Institute. George is also Pennsylvania's representative for NACo. George received the 2014 Governor's Award for Local Government Excellence in recognition of his contribution to local government in Pennsylvania. He also received the County Commissioner of the Year award from CCAP in 2014 and 2016. George is a proud graduate of the Pennsylvania State University.
